# Kargil Vijay Diwas – Courage, Sacrifice & Patriotism

## Objective:

To help students understand the significance of Kargil Vijay Diwas and honour the bravery and sacrifice of Indian soldiers, while developing reading, inquiry, reflection, and citizenship values through guided use of the Britannica Library.

## Students will:

- Understand why Kargil Vijay Diwas is observed
- Learn about the Kargil War and the bravery of Indian armed forces
- Develop reading comprehension and research skills
- Reflect on courage, sacrifice, and national responsibility

## Introduce the Weekly Theme / Genre:

Begin with a class discussion:

- What does the word *bravery* mean?
- Who protects our country?
- Why should we remember important events in our nation's history?

Explain that **Kargil Vijay Diwas is celebrated on 26 July** to commemorate India's victory in the Kargil War (1999) and to honour the soldiers who sacrificed their lives for the nation.

# Suggested Activities by Grade Band

## Grades IX – XII

- Students begin by reading and exploring articles from the Britannica Library to gain a deeper understanding of the Kargil War, its impact, and the values it represents. Encourage them to read thoughtfully and reflect on the human and national aspects of the event.
- Students explore topics such as:
  - Kargil War (overview and key events)
  - Kargil War – impact and course of the war
  - Stories of bravery and sacrifice
- You may guide them using prompts like:
  - What makes the Kargil War significant in India’s history?
  - What is the role of citizens in supporting the nation?
- Students will express their understanding through reflection and creativity.
- They will either:

Write a reflective paragraph on “Kargil Vijay Diwas: Remembering Our Heroes” .  
Make sure students mention the event and their reaction to the event

Design an infographic highlighting key ideas such as bravery, sacrifice, and national pride
