



# World Environment Day – Protecting Nature, Protecting Our Future

## Objective:

To help students understand the importance of protecting the environment and using natural resources responsibly, while developing reading, inquiry, and action-oriented thinking skills through guided use of Britannica Library.



## Students will:

- Understand why World Environment Day is observed
- Identify key environmental challenges and solutions
- Develop reading comprehension, note-making, and reflection skills
- Build a sense of responsibility toward nature and sustainability

## Introduce the Weekly Theme / Genre:

Begin with a class discussion:

- What do we mean by environment?
- How does nature help us in our daily life?

Explain that 5 June is observed worldwide to encourage people to protect and improve the environment.

# Suggested Activities by Grade Band

## Grades I & II

- Students begin by exploring pictures and short readings on nature using the Britannica Library. Encourage them to carefully observe and talk about different elements of the natural world.
- Students explore topics such as:
  - Trees and plants (how they grow and why they are important)
  - Animals and birds (their habitats and needs)
  - Clean surroundings (parks, rivers, and neighborhoods)
- You may guide them using examples like:
  - Trees
  - Elephant
  - Environment
- Ask students to observe carefully and discuss:
  - What do you see in the pictures?
  - Which part of nature do you like the most?
  - What makes our surroundings clean and healthy?
- Students will then express their ideas through drawing.
- They will draw:
  - One thing in nature they love (e.g., trees, animals, rivers, flowers)
- Encourage them to add simple labels or short sentences such as:
  - "I love trees."
  - "I will keep my surroundings clean."
