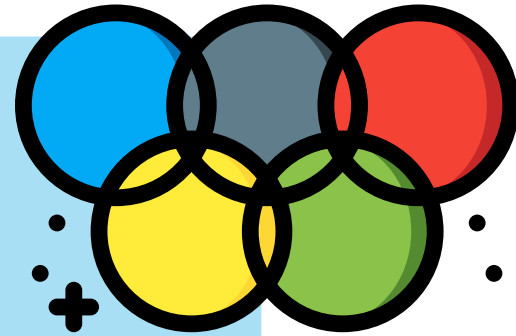

International Olympic Day – Excellence, Friendship & Fair Play

Objective:

To help students understand the Olympic values of excellence, respect, and friendship, while exploring the history and spirit of the Olympic Games through guided reading and inquiry using Britannica Library.



Students will:

- Understand the significance of International Olympic Day
- Learn about the Olympic Games and famous athletes
- Recognise values such as teamwork, perseverance, and fair play
- Develop reading, reflection, and discussion skills using authentic sources

Introduce the Weekly Theme / Genre:

Begin with a discussion:

- What is a sport?
- Why do people from different countries play together in the Olympics?

Explain that International Olympic Day (23 June) celebrates the founding of the modern Olympic Games and promotes participation in sports.

Suggested Activities by Grade Band

Grades I & II

- Students begin by exploring pictures and short readings on sports and teamwork using the Britannica Library. Encourage them to carefully observe and talk about different aspects of sports and playing together.
- Students explore topics such as:
 - Olympic sports (different games and how they are played)
- You may guide them using examples like:
 - Football
 - Running race
 - Team games
- Ask students to observe carefully and discuss:
 - What do you see in the pictures?
 - Which sport do you like the most?
 - How do players play fairly with each other?
- Students will then express their ideas through drawing.
- They will draw:
 - Their favourite sport (including players and action)
- Encourage them to add simple labels or short sentences such as:
 - "I like playing cricket."
 - "We should take turns."
 - "We must play fair."
- Students answer the question what did you learn today that you can now teach a classmate on the template attached or in their notebooks.

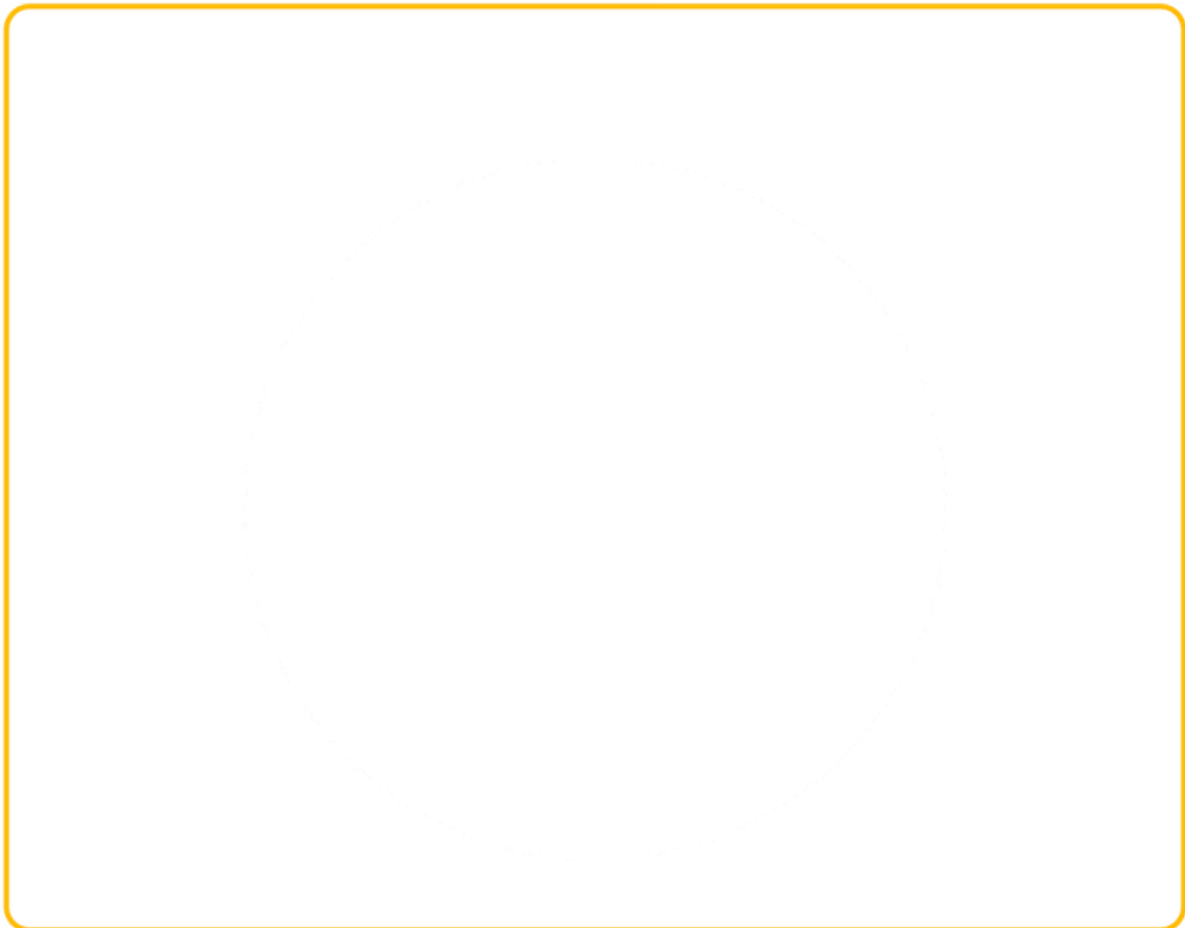
