# International Labour Day: Dignity in work builds dignity in life.

## Objective:

To help students understand the dignity of labour, recognise the contribution of different professions, and develop respect and empathy towards all forms of work through guided exploration using Britannica Library.

## Introduce the Weekly Theme / Genre:

Begin with a discussion:

- Who are the people who work to make our daily lives easier?
- Why is every type of work important in society?

Explain that International Labour Day (1 May) celebrates the hard work and contributions of workers across all fields, and reminds us to respect the dignity of labour and value every profession.

# Suggested Activities by Grade Band

## Grades III – V

- Choose a Worker
- Select one type of worker (e.g., farmer, construction worker, nurse, delivery person). Use Britannica Library to research.
- While reading, make notes on:
  - Nature of Work
    - What does the worker do daily?
    - What skills are needed?
  - Work Environment
    - Where do they work? (field, office, hospital, road, etc.)
    - What tools or equipment do they use?
  - Importance
    - Why is this job important for society?
    - How does it help others?
  - One Interesting Fact
    - Something surprising or unique about this job
  - Discuss Reflection
    - What did you find most interesting about this worker?
    - How would life be different without this job?
