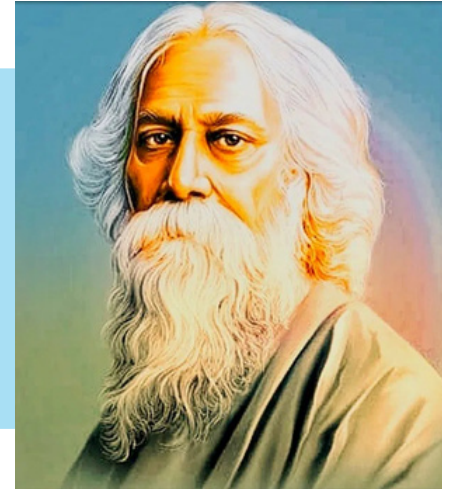

Rabindranath Tagore Jayanti

Objective:

To help students explore the life, contributions, and literary legacy of Rabindranath Tagore while developing appreciation for literature, creativity, and cultural heritage through guided exploration using Britannica Library.



Students will:

- Understand who Rabindranath Tagore was and why he is an important literary figure
- Recognise the role of literature, poetry, and art in expressing ideas and emotions
- Develop curiosity about Indian culture and heritage
- Strengthen reading, discussion, and creative thinking skills using Britannica Library

Introduce the Weekly Theme / Genre:

Begin with a discussion:

- What is a poem?
- Why do people write stories and poems?
- Have you heard of Rabindranath Tagore?

Suggested Activities by Grade Band

Grades IX – X

- Students begin by researching Rabindranath Tagore’s literary works and his role in Indian culture and education using the Britannica Library, building a deeper understanding of his lasting impact.
- Facilitate a brief discussion by asking:
 - Why is literature important in shaping society?
 - How do writers influence people’s thinking and perspectives?
 - What makes Tagore’s ideas still meaningful today?
- Students will reflect on their learning by writing a short paragraph on the topic:
 - “Why Rabindranath Tagore’s ideas remain relevant today.”
- Encourage students to include key ideas such as:
 - The importance of creativity and freedom in learning
 - The role of literature in expressing thoughts and emotions
 - How Tagore’s vision of education connects with today’s world
- They may use simple statements like:
 - “Tagore believed learning should be joyful and creative.”
 - “His ideas help us think freely and express ourselves.”
 - “His work is still important because it inspires better education.”
