# World Ozone Day – Protecting Our Sky

## Objective:

To build awareness about the ozone layer, environmental protection, and responsible actions through guided exploration using Britannica Library.



## Students will:

- Understand what the ozone layer is
- Identify causes of ozone depletion
- Develop environmental responsibility
- Use Britannica Library for environmental research

## Skills & Values:

## Introduce the Weekly Theme / Genre:

Begin with a class discussion:

- What protects us from the Sun's harmful rays?
- How can pollution affect our sky?

Explain that World Ozone Day, observed on 16th September, is celebrated to raise awareness about the importance of protecting the ozone layer and taking actions to safeguard our environment.

# Suggested Activities by Grade Band

## Grades I & II

- Students explore visuals of the Earth, sky, and Sun using Britannica Library to build observation and curiosity.
- They observe:
  - Colours in the sky (blue, orange, red during sunrise/sunset)
  - The Sun and its brightness
  - Clouds, stars, and other visible elements
- Encourage students to describe what they see using simple words.
- Students will observe, identify, and express creatively.
- They will:
  - List colours and elements seen in the sky (e.g., clouds, Sun, birds, stars)
  - Discuss how the sky looks different during day and night
  - Draw a picture of the Earth with a protective sky layer (atmosphere)
  - Use colours to show the sky and label basic elements
- Encourage creativity and neat representation.
