World Ozone Day – Protecting Our Sky

Objective:

To build awareness about the ozone layer, environmental protection, and responsible actions through guided exploration using Britannica Library.



Students will:

- Understand what the ozone layer is
- Identify causes of ozone depletion
- Develop environmental responsibility
- Use Britannica Library for environmental research

Introduce the Weekly Theme / Genre:

Begin with a class discussion:

- What protects us from the Sun's harmful rays?
- How can pollution affect our sky?

Explain that World Ozone Day, observed on 16th September, is celebrated to raise awareness about the importance of protecting the ozone layer and taking actions to safeguard our environment.

Suggested Activities by Grade Band

Grades III – V

- Students read simple, age-appropriate articles on the ozone layer using Britannica Library to understand its role in protecting Earth.
- They explore ideas such as:
 - What the ozone layer is
 - Why it is important for life on Earth
 - How it protects us from the Sun's harmful rays
- Students will identify causes, suggest solutions, and build responsible habits. They will:
 - Identify what harms the ozone layer (e.g., pollution, harmful gases like CFCs)
 - Write five positive daily actions they can take to protect the environment
- Share their ideas with the class or in small groups
- Encourage them to connect their daily actions with environmental protection.
