Introduce the Weekly Theme / Genre:

Begin with a class discussion:

- Introduce World Tourism Day and its importance
- Encourage curiosity about world cultures

Explain that World Tourism Day, observed on 27th September, celebrates the importance of travel and tourism in connecting cultures, promoting global understanding, and supporting economic development around the world.

Suggested Activities by Grade Band

Grades I & II

- Students begin by exploring pictures and short readings from the Britannica Library to learn about different countries.
- Explore:
 - Different countries and their names
 - How maps and globes represent the world
 - Basic features like land, water, and boundaries
- Students will explore, identify, and express creatively.
- They will:
 - Identify and read names of different countries
 - Explore and compare maps and globes
 - Choose their favourite place (country/city)
- Students will draw a simple map highlighting their favourite place
- Mark and label the name of the country clearly in their drawing
- Add basic elements like water bodies, land, or symbols
- Encourage neat labelling and creativity.
