Begin with a class discussion:

- Introduce World Tourism Day and its importance
- Encourage curiosity about world cultures

Explain that World Tourism Day, observed on 27th September, celebrates the importance of travel and tourism in connecting cultures, promoting global understanding, and supporting economic development around the world.

Suggested Activities by Grade Band

Grades VI- VIII

- Students use the Compare Countries feature on Britannica Library to explore and analyse two countries of their choice.
- They explore aspects such as:
 - Location and geography
 - Population and culture
- You may guide them with prompts like:
 - How are these two countries similar?
 - What makes them different?
 - Which country would you prefer to visit and why?
- Task:
- Students will compare, analyse, and organise information.
- They will:
 - Select two countries to compare
 - Identify key similarities and differences based on:
 - Capital cities
 - Language(s)
 - Culture or geography
- Students will create a Venn Diagram to showcase their learnings
