Introduce the Weekly Theme / Genre:

Begin with a class discussion:

- Introduce World Tourism Day and its importance
- Encourage curiosity about world cultures

Explain that World Tourism Day, observed on 27th September, celebrates the importance of travel and tourism in connecting cultures, promoting global understanding, and supporting economic development around the world.

Suggested Activities by Grade Band

Grades IX – X

- Students explore sustainable tourism articles on Britannica Library to understand how travel impacts the environment and cultures around the world.
- They explore ideas such as:
 - What sustainable tourism means
 - How tourism affects the environment (pollution, resource use)
 - How tourism influences local cultures and communities
- Encourage students to connect global issues with real-life travel experiences.
- Task:
- Students will analyse, reflect, and suggest solutions. They will:
 - Analyse the environmental impact of tourism (e.g., pollution, waste, damage to ecosystems)
 - Analyse the cultural impact of tourism (e.g., preservation or loss of traditions, local livelihoods)
 - Suggest practical ways to travel responsibly.
