
# **CREATE A VISUAL ESSAY**



# **GRADE LEVEL 9-10**

#### OBJECTIVES





## \_ Students Will:

- 1. Identify a theme found in a text (novel, short story, poem, newspaper article, etc.) and analyze its development, including how it might be represented visually.
- 2. Use information from the text for analysis and reflection of the identified theme.
- 3. Use digital media (*Britannica ImageQuest*) to locate images that representing the identified theme.
- 4. Create a photo or image essay, demonstrating an understanding of the theme by image choice (context, figurative, connotative, and/or technical meaning).

### **ACTIVITY**

Students will create a visual essay using images from *Britannica ImageQuest* based on a theme found in a literary text (novel or short story), poem, or informational text (newspaper, magazine, or journal article).

Examples of possible themes: society and wealth, the "American dream," poverty, love, hope, effects of crime on the family, etc.

Activity option: Create a slide show of photographs or illustrations (using video, PowerPoint, iMovie, etc.), adding music or spoken words to enhance the chosen theme.
