




Each LaunchPack contains a variety of content including Articles, Images, Videos, Primary Sources, and Websites.

Table of Contents


Expand or collapse the table of contents using the + or - symbols. Click on a section title to navigate to that section of the article.

Page Tools

Use Page Tools to reduce or enlarge text size, print the full article, generate a citation, translate the article, or create an article excerpt.



Dictionary

Double-click any word to see a Quick-Click dictionary definition! Powered by Merriam-Webster. Students can also listen to the pronunciation of the words by clicking the audio box.



Read Aloud

Click the play icon to hear the article read aloud.

Media Tools: Images & Videos


Media Sharing

Annotations


Click "Annotations" to begin annotating an article within the LaunchPack.

Highlight and Annotate

Share Annotations


Click the envelope icon under Annotation Tools to share your annotations via e-mail.

Insert your own KAHOOT! Quiz to assess student knowledge.






Schedule a LaunchPack

Schedule a LaunchPack to your Personal Calendar using the "Send to" drop-down button.


Collection of LaunchPacks


Learning Strategies

Learning Strategies are skillbuilding exercises that develop subject-area literacy.

Types of Strategies

Click "Activities" to select from 4 Learning Strategies: Main Idea, Summary, Main Idea and Summary, and Journal.





Choose a Resource

Select an article to apply the Learning Strategy. You can choose to assign an excerpt or the full text of the article.

Edit the Instructions

Edit or save the default instructions. Don't forget, you can assign multiple Learning Strategies to a single resource.




Question Sets

Created by Britannica experts, these open-ended questions can be applied to many topics. Choose to use a whole set or select your preferred questions.






Questions by Category

Prior to saving your activity, preview the LaunchPack from student preview.



Access all your drafted, scheduled, and open Activities from the Activities Dashboard.


Progress Bar

Dictionary


Double-click any word within an article or primary source to see a Quick-Click dictionary definition. Students can also listen to the pronunciation of the word by clicking the audio box.


