Strategy Card: Building the Big Picture!

Get Started: Have students examine the two images below.

Activity: Ask them to make a connection between the two images. There may be a variety of answers for the connections (women in flight, women, aviation, barrier breakers, women's first, etc.). Regardless of the connection, have students use Britannica School to find additional images with the same connection. They can copy and paste these images onto a Google slide or a Microsoft Word document, or they can save them to a Resource Pack within Britannica School. (Depending on the student's background knowledge of the individuals provided, they might need to evaluate each image further before deciding on a connection. The "Building the Big Picture!" graphic organizer is a great way to help scaffold this activity for students.)
